Malvazija

Malvasia is an old variety of white wine that comes from a greek city on the penninsula Peloponnese called Monemvasie. The main role in spreading the flavour of Malvasia had the Venetians who changed the name of the city to Malvasia. The Venetians loved malvasia so much that all the „osterie“ in Italy that served that wine had to be called Malvasia. Istrian Malvasia is a white wine containing between 11.5 and 13.5% alcohol. Connoisseurs describe it as a full, rounded and harmonious wine with a great fruity and floral aromatic potential.

Teran

The first mention of Teran wine dates back to the fourteenth century, when it was served in ceramic bottles to imperial emissaries. Until some one hundred years ago, it was the most widespread variety in Istria. Teran is a wine with character, strength, persistency and slightly higher acidity. Typically the wine of Istrian farm workers and domestic households, it also found its way to the tables of nobility. The wine's rich, robust character is evident while the grapes are still on the vines. Teran grows in large clusters of densely packed berries with resistant skins. When you bite into a berry, its pulp bursts into your mouth. If you are looking for an authentic experience or something new, teran is the right choice. It is said to be the colour of hare's blood. If you swirl it in your glass, you can catch a glimpse of purple tones. Teran is best served at about 18 degrees. It is a wine of great potential and impending success, as wines lovers in Europe and around the world begin to learn more about this hidden jewel among Istrian wines.
